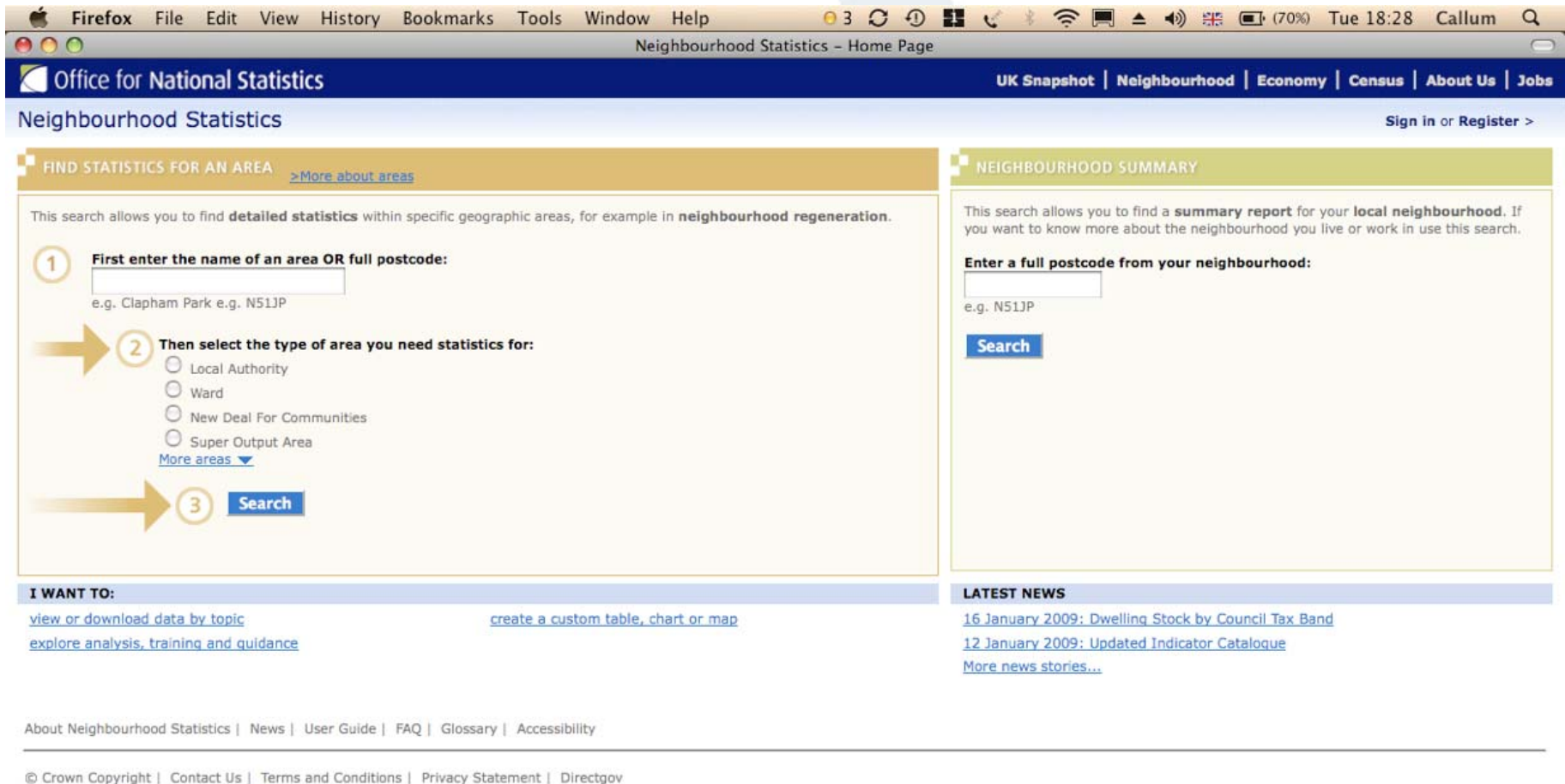

What is it?

- It isn't particularly sexy...

- It's about enabling better transfer of data between systems

..but it does offer access to the same data

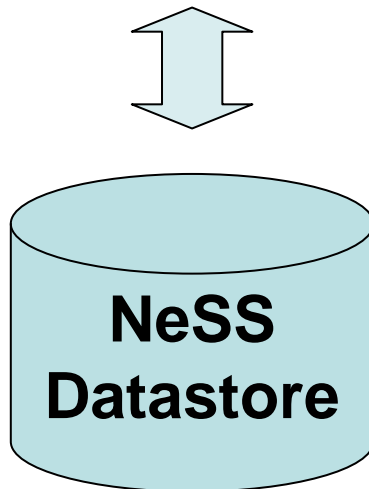
- Over a billion data items for a range of geographical areas
- Data 'as loaded' and also as constituted to alternative areas
- Range of topics and sources (from across government)
- 10,000 cell limit for a single delivery

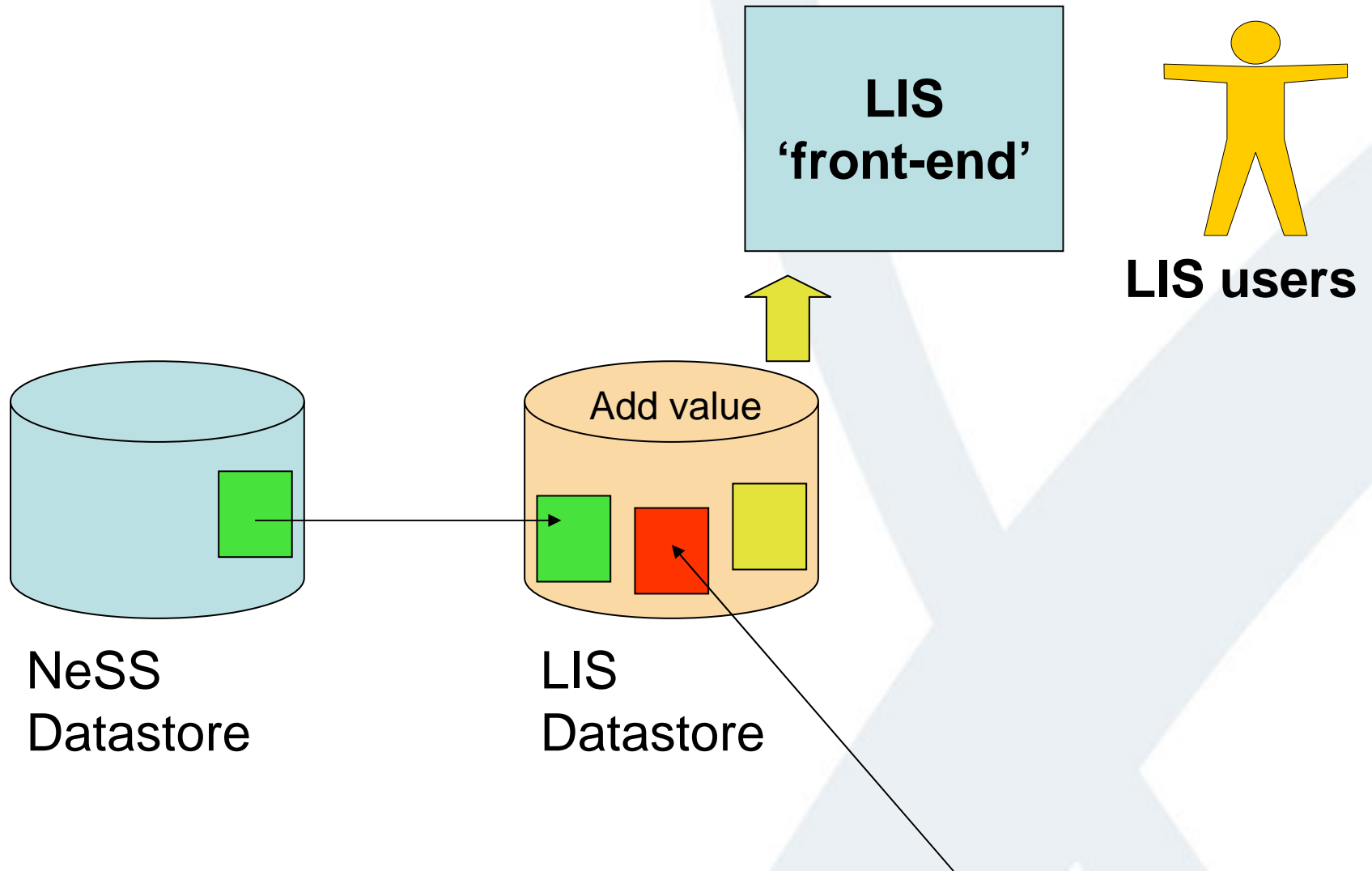

Who is it aimed at?

Is it for me?

- Systems that want to re-use data from NeSS for their own audiences and purposes
- Particular focus on Local Information Systems

Combining data for LIS users



So.. what actually is it?

- It's a 'web service'..
- A method by which other systems can query the NeSS datastore, and request and receive data.
 - Query = “**Discovery**”
 - Request and Receive = “**Delivery**”
- Transfer of data in 'xml'
 - delivery in 'LGDX'

Is it for me?

- If you have a Local Information System that uses data from NeSS then you should certainly have a look..
- Looking to engage with 3rd party suppliers

for other systems

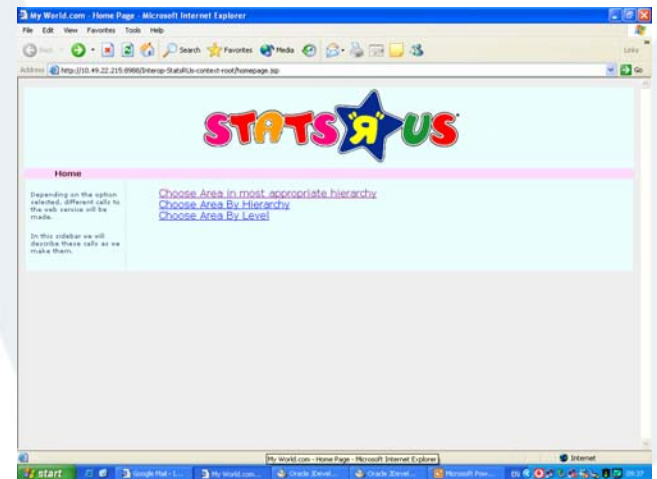
- Efficiencies

Demonstrators

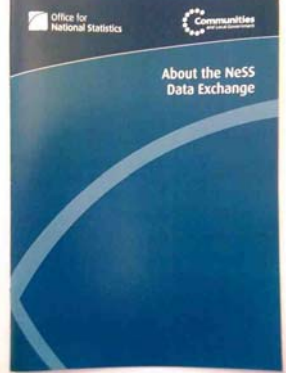
- We have developed some demonstrators which show how the NDE can be used... ‘Hunter’ and ‘Gatherer’
- Different technologies
 - Ajax
 - Excel
 - Java
 - .Net
 - Working on Adobe Flex Demo
- Created for people to look to see how works and re-use code as required

- Beta version released April 2008
- V1.0 release in December 2008
 - Now increasing awareness activities
- V1.1 release due in Spring 2009
 - Minor improvements
- Further development plans to be decided
