How do people feel about using technology and data in health care?

Bus services: local transport authority capacity and capability - England This Department for Transport (DfT) research provides information on the <u>capacity</u> and <u>capability</u> of local transport authorities in England concerning bus service planning and provision.

Annual bus statistics: year ending March 2023 – Great Britain

These DfT annual statistics provide information on <u>local buses in Great Britain</u> for the year ending March 2023.

Concessionary travel statistics: year ending March 2023 - England

These DfT <u>concessionary bus travel statistics</u> provide information about the number of passes, bus journeys, reimbursement and expenditure in England for the year ending March 2023.

Quarterly bus fares statistics: July to September 2023 - Great Britain

These DfT <u>local bus fare statistics</u> provide information on fare costs in Great Britain for July to September 2023.

Transport statistics Great Britain - 2022

This DfT report provides information on <u>statistical trends in the British transport</u> <u>sector for 2022</u>.

Daily domestic transport use by mode in Great Britain – January 2022

This DfT report provides information on the <u>daily usage of selected domestic</u> transport by mode in Great Britain since January 2022.

Provisional road traffic estimates: October 2022 to September 2023– Great Britain

These DfT statistics provide provisional estimates for <u>road traffic in Great Britain for</u> the year ending September 2023, by vehicle type and road class.

Passenger rail usage: July to September 2023 – Great Britain

These <u>Office of Rail and Road (ORR) quarterly statistics</u> provide information on the volume of passenger journeys, kilometres and revenue on the mainline network in Great Britain between July and September 2023.

A systematic review of the impacts of extreme heat on health and wellbeing in the UK

A <u>new study</u>, led by the University of the West of England, looks at gaps in our knowledge between the urban environment and heatwaves, indoor heat, and non-communicable diseases such as cancers, heart disease and asthma.

Housing - England

Local Authority Housing Statistics published by the Department for Levelling Up, Housing & Communities (DLUHC) 2022/23 figures show that the <u>number of Local</u> <u>Authority owned dwellings</u> in England was 1,571,456 down from 1,575,709 in 2021/22. For the first time there are separate figures for vacant dwellings owned within the HRA <u>temporarily unavailable for letting</u> at 11,613 in England and <u>permanently unavailable for letting</u> at 6,285. <u>Total HRA vacant</u> was 32,420 for 2022/23 up from 31,560 in 2021/22. Data by number of bedrooms is also available in LG Inform.

NHS England figures show that <u>finished admission episodes with a primary or</u> <u>secondary diagnosis of obesity per 100,000 population</u> in England for 2022/23 was 2,225 up from 2,056 in 2021/22. <u>Female</u> rate for England was 2,788 compared to <u>Male</u> at 1,643.
