# Gambling survey for Great Britain - statistics on gambling participation – Year 1 (2023), Wave 1

The gambling survey for Great Britain from the Gambling Commission explores gambling participation and behaviours. This data is the <u>first edition of the survey</u> where a nationally representative sample of 4,801 adults aged 18 and over were interviewed during the period July to November 2023.

#### Public opinions and social trends, Great Britain: 13 to 24 March 2024

This Office for National Statistics (ONS) <u>social insights article</u> provides information on daily life and events from the Opinions and Lifestyle Survey (OPN) relating to the biggest issues facing society today and covers the period 13 to 24 March 2024.

This report from Coram provides the <u>results of the 23<sup>rd</sup> annual childcare survey</u>. It provides information on the prices of childcare, the availability of childcare, pressures on providers, additional charges by providers and readiness for the expansion of funded entitlements in England.

#### School capacity in England: academic year 2022 to 2023

These DfE <u>school capacity statistics</u> provide information on school places, unfilled school places, pupils over capacity, pupil number forecasts and place planning in England for the academic year 2022 to 2023.

The Crime Survey for England and Wales 2019 found that for one in 10 adults who had been sexually abused in childhood, the abuse had been carried out by a person in a position of trust or authority. The Centre of Expertise on Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) have summarised the most up-to-date research on abuse in institutions into a short paper.

### **Local Government**

#### Local government budget setting for 2024/25

The <u>Local government budget setting report</u> explores the challenges that councils have faced in trying to set a balanced budget for upcoming financial year, including the services most likely to be impacted by cost savings and the anticipated consequences of these cost savings. The report combines the findings of two surveys of council chief executives, conducted before and after the announcement at the end of January of an additional £600m in funding for councils.

Research into councils with experience of finance and governance challenges In September 2022, the LGA commissioned Human Engine to conduct a desktop study on five councils with experience of finance and governance challenges which led to either a S114 report or a capitalisation direction with a governance review at the time the research was commissioned. A series of roundtables were held to reflect on the findings of the research and the recommendations. LGA have published a summary of learning which sets out the findings from the research and roundtables.

#### **Trust in Government, UK: 2023**

These ONS statistics provide information on <u>trust in government and institutions</u>, opinions and experiences of public services, and attitudes towards political issues in the UK in 2023

#### The state of local government finance in England 2024

This report is the <u>11th annual state of local government finance survey in England</u>, from the Local Government Information Unit (LGIU). This report, for the first time, demonstrates how challenging the current fiscal climate for councils is.

#### Metrics added to LG Inform this month include:

#### **Statutory homelessness**

The Department for Levelling Up, Housing & Communities (DLUHC) have added new metrics to the Statutory homelessness collection, and these have been added to LG Inform. They include:

• Reason for loss of last settled home for households owed a relief duty - End of assured shorthold (AST) private rented tenancy, due to landlord wishing to sell the property which was 1,310 for England in Quarter 2 2023/24, down from 1,340 in Quarter 1.

- Reason for loss of last settled home for households owed a relief duty Domestic abuse - of which: Victim which was 6,580 for England in Quarter 2 2023/24, up from 6,050 in Quarter 1.
- Support needs of households owed a prevention or relief duty Number of support needs of which households with: Difficulties budgeting which was 3,720 for England in Quarter 2 2023/24, up from 3,600 in Quarter 1.
- Accommodation at time of application of households owed a relief duty
   No fixed abode of which: Slept rough in the last year which was 1,290 for England in Quarter 2 2023/24, down from 1,340 in Quarter 1.
